

Domino RME LLC SPDES Permit Application Fact Sheet

Domino RME LLC submitted a SPDES permit application for the proposed Non-Potable Water Production Facility (“NWPF”) located at 328 Kent Ave, Brooklyn, New York. Application ID# 2-6101-00152/00016. As part of the application, Domino RME LLC is required to inform the public about the project, SPDES permit application status and involve them in the process.

Why does Domino RME LLC need to apply for a SPDES permit? Domino RME LLC needs a SPDES permit to utilize the existing outfall to discharge treated non-potable water produced by the NWPF to the East River.

How might this permit application affect the surrounding community? The SPDES permit application would enable the Domino District to reduce its impact on NYC’s potable water and wastewater systems, while also helping to reduce the occurrence of combined sewer overflow (CSO) events and pollutant loads emitted into the East River.

How can I participate in the permit application review process? You may provide comments at the virtual public meeting to be considered in the permit review process. Comments may also be given in writing during the NYSDEC public comment period.
